### **English & Literacy**

This term, we will be developing our knowledge of Vocabulary, Connectives, Openers and Punctuation (VCOP), handwriting and spelling. The children will be using up-levelling techniques to improve the standard of their writing. This process also involves self and peer assessment.

Through the IDL context of The Rainforest, our writing will focus on a variety of genres including description of a scene, fact files, letter writing, instructions and advertisements.


Our reading in term 1 will focus on skimming and scanning and non-fiction texts. Reading homework will be linked to reading skills and due every Friday.



#### **Maths & Numeracy**

This term, our grouped maths work will focus on place value and addition and subtraction.

In connection with the IDL topic of The Rainforest and Money Week, pupils will be looking in more depth at finance and budgeting, profit and loss as well as information handling.



# **Interdisciplinary Learning: The Rainforest**

This term our context for learning is The Rainforest. We will be exploring this through the curriculum areas of Social Studies, Literacy and Expressive Arts. The key questions we will look at are:

- Where is the rainforest and what is it?
- Who and what lives there?
- How does the rainforest benefit us?
- Why is it in danger?
- What can we do to help?

#### Trip to the Zoo
