Grammar: Nouns, adjectives and punctuation.

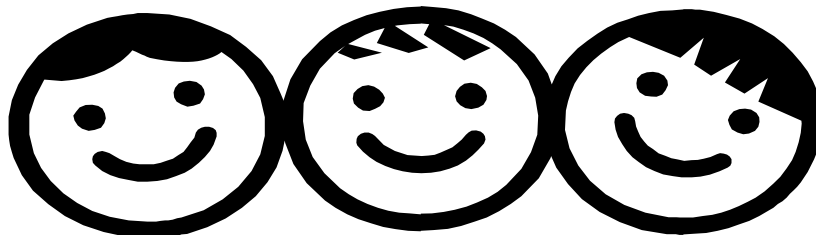
Reading: Summarising a text. Literacy circles.
