English & Literacy

Through the IDL context of Mid Calder, our writing will focus on a variety of genres including description of a scene, questionnaire, invitation, poetry and advertisement posters.

This term, we will continue to develop our knowledge of Vocabulary, Connectives, Openers and Punctuation (VCOP), as well as building on our handwriting and spelling abilities. The children will use up-levelling techniques to improve the standard of their writing. This process also involves self and peer assessment.

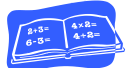
Our reading in term 2 will focus on identifying the author's purpose of a text. To support with this at home, please encourage your child to read a range of texts such as books, magazines, posters, adverts, timetables, invitations etc. and discuss the author's purpose e.g. to persuade, entertain or inform the reader.



Maths & Numeracy

This term, our maths work will focus on Stages of Early Arithmetical Learning (SEAL) strategies and we will explore aspects of learning across number. Through our IDL context, we will also explore money.

You can support your child's maths development at home by regular number bonds practice, counting up different monetary amounts and coin and note recognition.
