Have a break and watch this story called 'Taking Flight'.

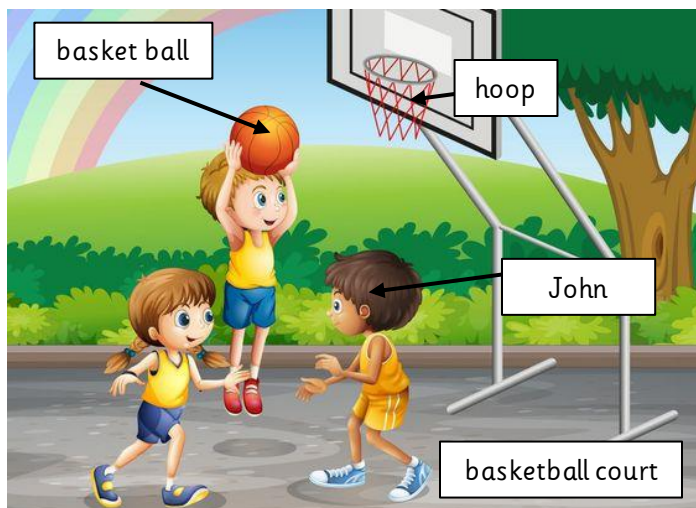
