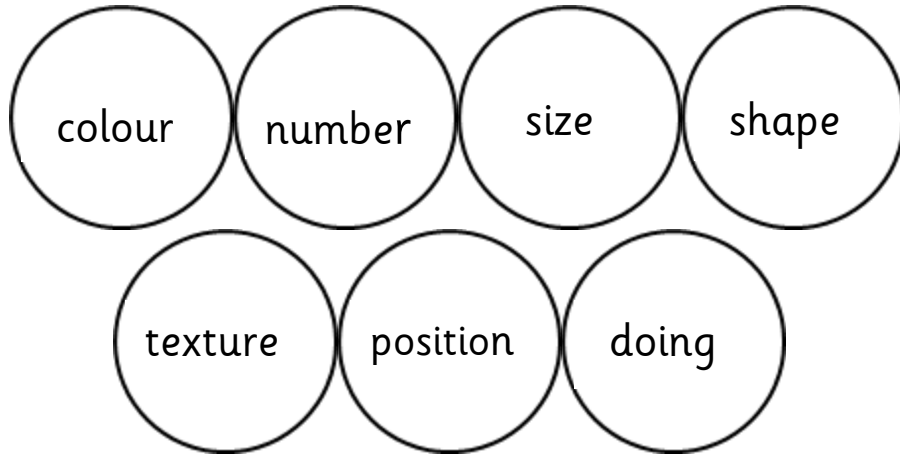


## Literacy
