Writing



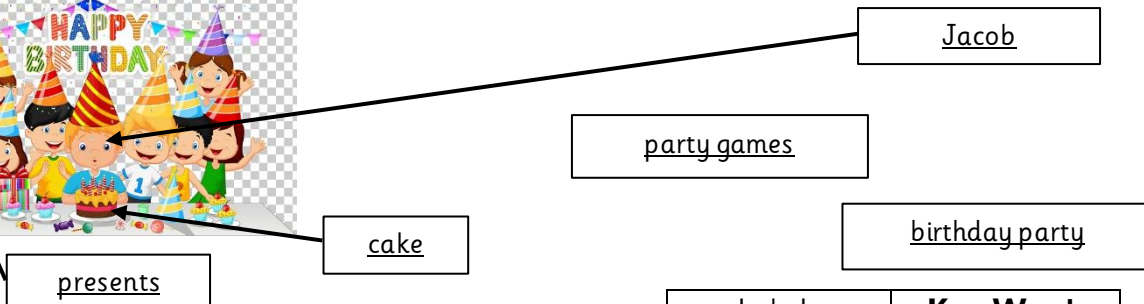
As we were off on Monday and Tuesday I have uploaded the first 3 writing lessons today. You can choose to do bits of them or all of them, it's up to you.

Lesson 1 (Monday):

Have a look at the picture below. Think about what we do in class when learning about recounts. We start by looking at a picture with **labels** and **key words**. We look at the picture, read the labels then use the key words to help share oral sentences about what might be going on. Try this with an adult.

Key words: went, was, opened, played, ate

Example of an oral sentence using key words and labels: "It **was** Jacob's party".



Lesson 2 (Tuesday):

Here is the recount about eating in a restaurant.

The Birthday Party

Yesterday I **went** to a birthday party. It **was** Jacob's party. He **opened** presents. We **played** some party games. We **ate** some cake. It **was** fun at the party.

This time I want you to imagine that you went to Amy's birthday party. Can you use the key words and labels below to write your own recount? (Use the recount above to think about which sentences you might write!)

Labels	Key Words

<u>presents</u>	was
<u>pass the parcel</u>	opened
<u>sandwiches</u>	played
<u>music</u>	danced

Lesson 3:

For now, just draw your pictures and labels.

Can you share with an adult, 3 interesting things you found out about Mary after watching this video? Would you like to be a fossil hunter like Mary?

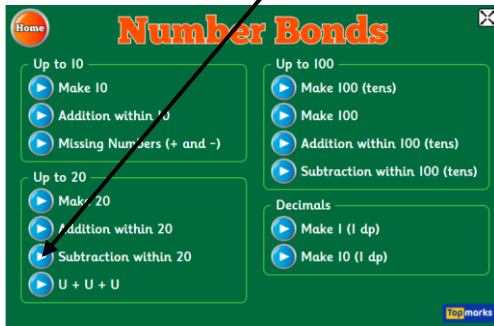

How many sums can you get right in the time given? Play Again to see if you can beat your score!

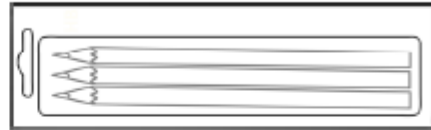
Numeracy

Aim: I can solve two-step problems involving addition and subtraction.

1. John buys 12 pencils one week and 7 the following week. He gives 3 pencils to his friend.

How many pencils does he have left?



2. Lydia has 15 marbles. She takes them to her friend's house. She loses 3 on the way and 4 in the house.

How many does she have left?



3. Asif has a packet of biscuits. There are 12 in the packet. He gives 6 of the biscuits to some friends. He buys another packet of 12 biscuits.

How many biscuits does he have now?
