## Superheroes Topic - Superheroes and Super Powers!

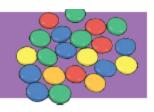

## Cola Super Fountain

## Method

- Before you carry out the experiment, you may wish to add a cape and a superhero outfit to the bottle of diet cola.
- Carry out this experiment outside, with the children at least 3m away from the experiment. It's messy!
- Remove the lid of the bottle and quickly add the mints. Stand back!
- The cola will shoot out of the bottle in a fountain.

## You will need:

2l bottle diet cola

Mentos mint sweets

A superhero cape and face for the bottle (optional)
