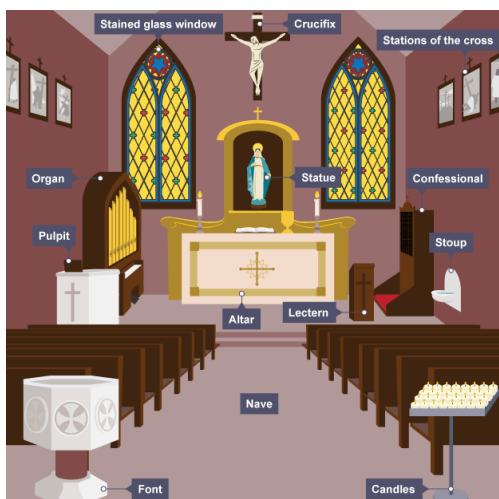
## RME

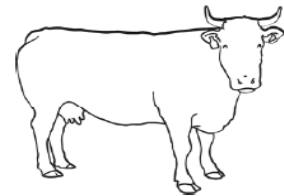
You will be asked to write down your answers and then you can see how many you got right at the end!
