
Mental Maths Warm Up



Magic Box - Guess the pattern!

You will need a box and either some cubes, counters, lego or even pasta shapes.

This box is now the magic box! It produces a pattern and children have to identify that pattern. E.g. Put 1 cube in, children close their eyes and whisper 'abracadara' and 2 cubes come out.... then 4 cubes.... then 8.... Children identify that the box is doubling the cubes and then predict what will come out next. This can be used for other patterns, e.g. adding 2,3,4, or 5 each time, or counting in 2s, 10s, 5s. For each pattern, the children will first identify what the pattern is and then use that to predict the next amount to come out of the box.



What is the pattern? You are adding two each time! So what would be next in the pattern? 7!





Have a go at today's numeracy worksheets that I have uploaded to the blog. There are two levels of difficulty so you can decide which one you will try or have a go at both! Remember strategies we have used in class and if you have counters or cubes at home you can use them. If you don't have cubes or counters try using pasta shapes or other objects for counting.
