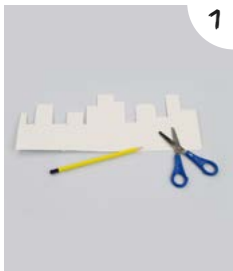

Handprint Flying Superhero

Supplies

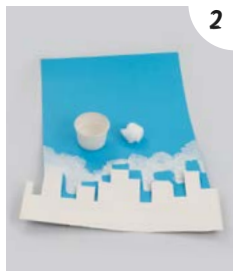
- Blue or white paper
- Selection of coloured paint
- Cotton wool
- Paint brush
- Felt tip pens
- Spare card



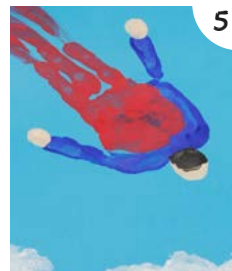
1 Using the spare card, draw a city sky line shape which is long enough to reach across the bottom of the page. Then cut this out.



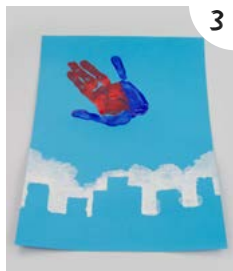
4 Then using your painted fingers, drag behind the fingers of the hand print, to make it seem like the hand print is flying!



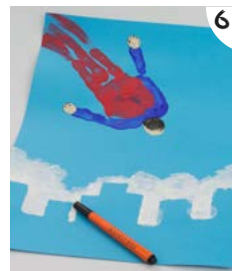
2 Use this as a stencil by placing it over the bottom of the paper. Then use cotton wool balls to dab white paint onto the paper to give the effect of clouds. Remove the stencil to leave behind a city sky line, then leave to dry.



5 Now give your superhero a face! To do this, make a large thumb print overlapping the heel of the hand. You may wish to print a smaller print in a darker colour for hair. Or add two smaller skin toned prints for hands.

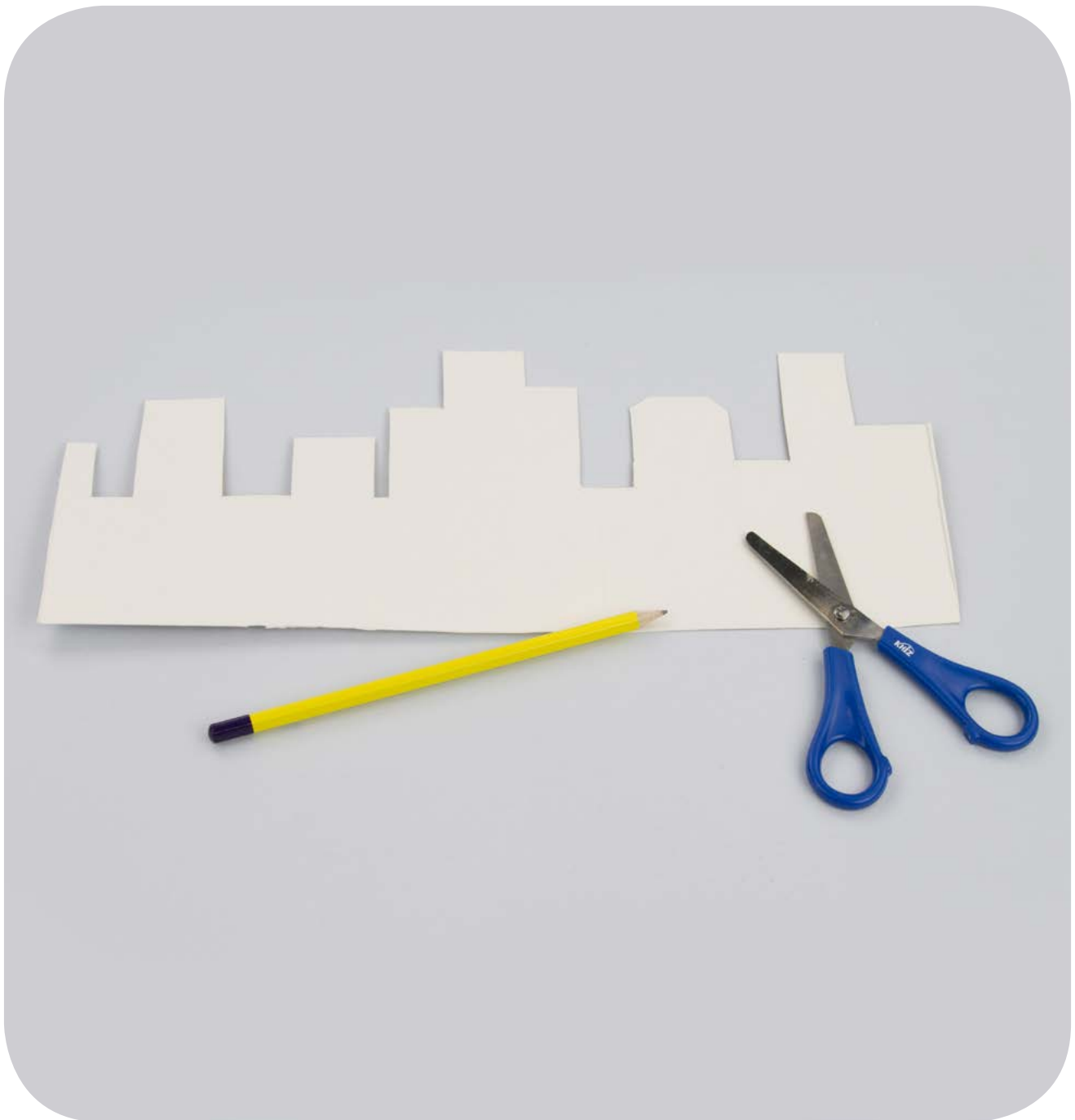
Handprint Flying Superhero



Supplies

- Blue or white paper

Step 1. Using the spare card, draw a city sky line shape which is long enough to reach across the bottom of the page. Then cut this out.
