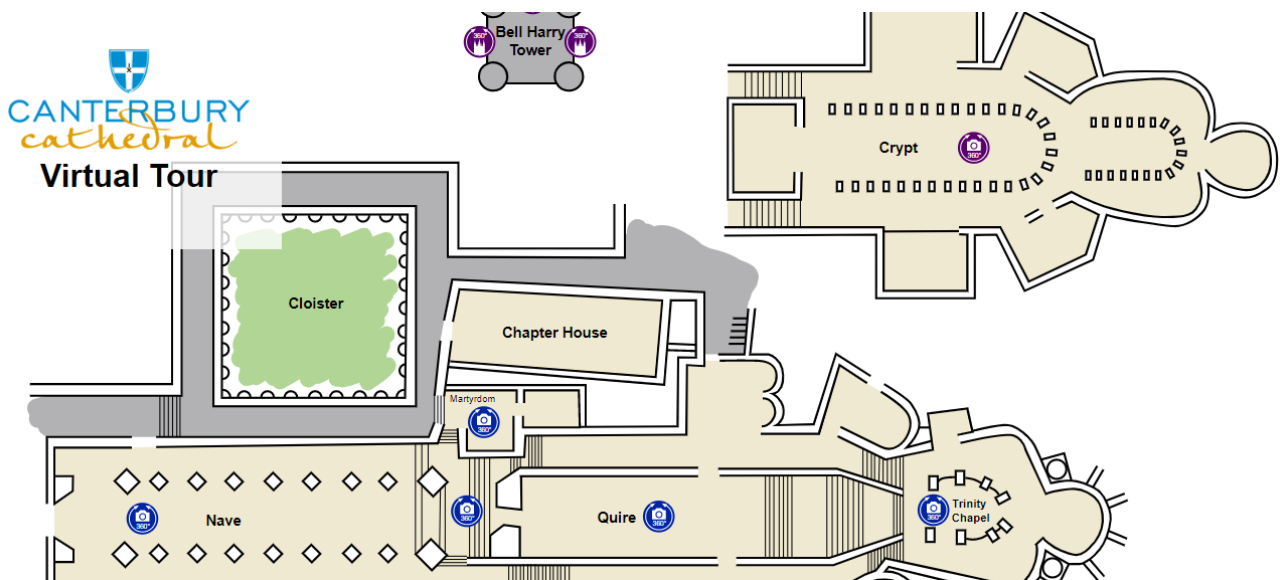

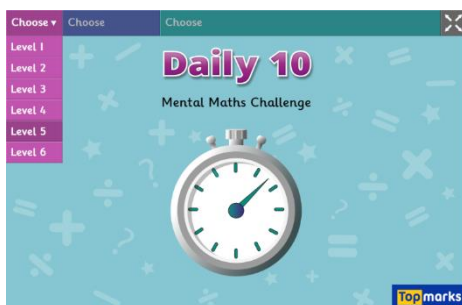
Superheroes Topic
