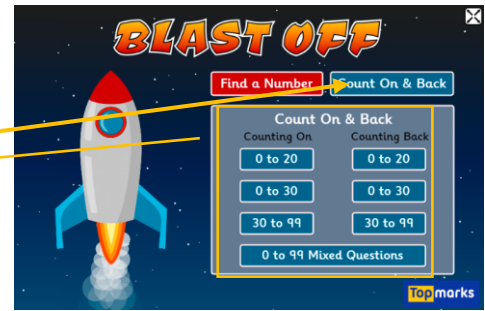


## Blast Off

Let's have a go at some problem solving! Green is mild, orange is spicy and red is hot!

Challenge yourself: Think.....What is important information? What operation do I use? + or -

- 15 vultures were feeding off the body of a tyrannosaurus. Another 6 vultures joined them. How many vultures were feeding?
- 17 tyrannosauruses got locked in battle with another 4 tyrannosauruses, How many tyrannosauruses were in battle?
