<p><u>LSCWC</u></p> <p>Write each word 5 times using Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check</p> 	<p><u>Rainbow Write</u></p> <p>Choose 3 different colours, and rainbow write each word.</p> 	<p><u>Writing Race</u></p> <p>Set a timer for 3 minutes. See how many times you can write your words perfectly during that time.</p> 
<p><u>Type a word</u></p> <p>Use a laptop/computer or notes section of a tablet or smart phone to type out your words. Try using at least 3 different fonts and/or colours!</p> <p>e.g. bat bat bat</p>	<p><u>Sing and Spell</u></p> <p>Sing Hickety Tickety Bumble Bee and spell your words.</p> <p>Hickety tickety bumble bee, Can you say the word for me?</p>  <p>Now spell it – say, shout, whisper clap or stomp as you spell each word out loud!</p>	<p><u>Splat a word</u></p> <p>Write all your words on a bit of paper and lay them out on the table. Play with a partner. The first person to find and splat the word with their hand is the winner.</p>
