P5, P6 and P7 children will now be undertaking outdoor learning on **Tuesdays and Wednesdays**.

Please ensure the children come dressed for outdoor learning on these days. Please supply spare socks and suitable waterproof clothing and footwear. We do have a limited number of spare waterproof trousers and spare coats. Thank you.

To support social distancing we are still adopting a soft start for all classes from 8.30 am.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast club will resume from next Monday 8.00 to 8.30 a.m. from front office entrance. After 8.30 a.m pupils are expected to enter school using their appointed entrance.



Please adhere to the wearing of facemasks and avoid lingering at gates and pathways to minimise interactions between groups. Please leave and collect your children promptly and do not allow children to play with other children from different classes whilst on school premises.
