# English and Literacy



**Phonics/Spelling**: We will continue to revise and introduce new sounds and continue to develop our blending skills using the Jolly Phonics guidance and active learning tasks.

**Writing:** We will continue to consolidate and introduce new tricky words. We will continue to follow the PM writing scheme focusing on procedures and revising information reports by applying our skills to different contexts for writing.

**Reading:** We will be focussing on familiar settings, fantasy settings, stories from different cultures and poetry through whole class reading lessons using the Literacy Evolve scheme this term.

**Modern Languages:** We will continue to focus on Spanish with Miss Talavero and French with Mrs Walker.

## Numeracy and Maths



**Numeracy**: We will continue revising using SEAL programme (Stages of Early Arithmetical Learning), particularly focussing on making progress with grouping/arrays (multiplication), division and fractions of shapes/amounts.

**Maths**: In addition, we will also be focussing on developing our skills in time and position and movement including simple grid references.

**Digital Learning:** We will continue to make use of digital technologies such as SUMDOG, Education City and SEESAW to set tasks to develop and expand upon our learning in class. We will also revisit programming Beebots in position and movement games.

# Interdisciplinary Learning (IDL)

In term 3, we will continue with our "Vikings" topic for the first few weeks back. Our second context for learning, chosen in consultation and voting by the children is "In the Garden". We plan to explore questions such as:

- 1. What kinds of minibeasts and animals can we find outside?
- 2. How do plants grow and how can we help take care of them?
- 3. How do we predict what the weather will be? How can we measure the weather?
- 4. How can we help care for our environment?
