Spelling

We will follow a spelling progression using differentiated activities with new spelling words issued each week including tasks for homework.

Writing and Grammar:

Using the 'PM Writing' scheme, we will focus on grammar and writing skills linked to narrative texts.

We will be using guided reading sessions to explore key reading skills with the aim to facilitate literacy circles later in the term. We will also continue to develop our reading comprehension and higher order thinking skills.

Interdisciplinary Learning (IDL)
