English & Literacy

This term we will continue to introduce and build upon alternative ways to make sounds. We will be developing our handwriting further using Jolly Phonics read, write and revise process. We will also continue to develop our skills in tricky words and sentence building.

This term, we will continue to use our Jolly Phonics readers. These books include a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts and will allow children to practise blending skills.

Our writing will continue to follow our PM writing scheme with our focus being descriptions & recounts.

Maths & Numeracy

This term we will continue to consolidate our number sequences to 30 and beyond, focusing on numbers before and after, and also identifying numerals.

We will also continue to focus on developing our counting strategies. We will also be consolidating our skills in skip counting, counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

We will also be looking at symmetry and pattern through our IDL context.

Interdisciplinary Learning

This term our context for learning is 'In the Garden. We will be learning about this context through the curriculum areas of Social Studies, Science and Expressive arts. The key questions we will explore are:

- Where do plants come from?
- What are the different parts of the plants?
 - What creatures are in the Garden?
- What is the difference between different insects and bugs?
