We have had a very positive start to the new school year and have a very busy term ahead of us.

In literacy we will begin looking at Literacy Circles as a way to develop comprehension of what we are reading. We will also be looking at a variety of grammar areas to improve our writing skills. In numeracy we will be developing our knowledge of fractions, percentages and decimals and working on our existing understanding of data handling linking it into our topic work. Our term one topic is Global Citizenship, ECO and Fair Trade. The children have been planning what and how they would like to learn about our topic. We will continue with French as our modern language however we will also be introducing Spanish as part of the West Lothian Council's policy for children to be learning two languages throughout their primary and secondary education.

All children will get two hours of P.E. per week; one session with Mrs Logan, our P.E. specialist and an outdoor session with Miss Preston. We will be continuing (weather permitting) with our 'Daily Mile' initiative. PE will be on a Monday (outdoor) and a Tuesday. Children's outdoor PE kit does not have to stay in school.

Teaching

Miss Preston will be in class all day on a Monday, Tuesday and Friday and a Wednesday morning. Mrs Harrison will be in class on a Wednesday afternoon and all day Thursday. Both teachers will be working very closely with all planning, teaching and assessment.
