In literacy we will continue to use Literacy Circles as a way to develop comprehension of what we are reading. We will also be looking at a variety of grammar areas to improve our writing skills. In numeracy we will be developing our knowledge and understanding of the four key numeracy concepts of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be looking at coordinates via our WWII topic. We will be continuing with our Rainforest topic until the February break. We will then be moving onto WWII.
