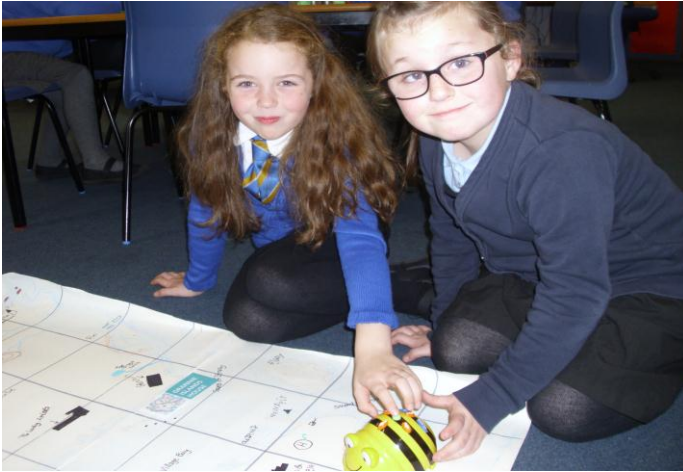


# P3T News
