In literacy we will continue to use Literacy Circles and will be using Reading Routes as a way to develop reading and comprehension skills, we are also using Thinking Dice to develop our questioning skills. We will be looking at a range of areas of grammar to improve our writing. In math and numeracy we will be covering measure, time, shape and angles. Our interdisciplinary topic is The Human Body. Health & Wellbeing focus for P7 is Keeping Myself Safe and for P6 is Knowing Me, Knowing You and Sex & Emotional Wellbeing. The children will be continuing to develop their knowledge and understanding of both French and Spanish languages.

In PE the children will be developing their basketball skills and team work skills through team games.
