

Mark Making

Support your child to practice mark making. Try using a stick to do some mark making in the snow. Encourage your child to make marks moving from left to right.

Share a story

Cuddle up and share a story with your child. Use one of the big bedtime read stories or one of your own. Talk to your child about what they liked about the story

Play a game

Play a game with your child. Encourage them to take turns. If you are playing a dice game help them to count the dots on the dice to develop their understanding of numbers and dice patterns

Count footprints

Help your child to count their footsteps in the snow. Can they see any other footprints in the snow? Help them to guess what animal or person made them.

Make a Picture

Encourage your child to make marks to create a snowy picture. They can bring their picture into nursery to show the nursery team.

Build something

Play with your child in the snow. Help them to build something with the snow. Talk to them about how the snow feels and what happens when it melts. Take a photo of your child's snow creation and post it on the learners journey.
