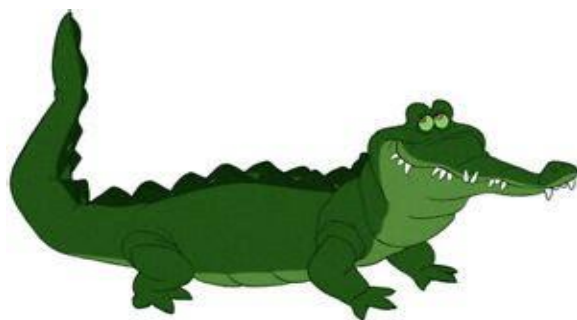
I can't help you with this. I don't know who is in your family.
