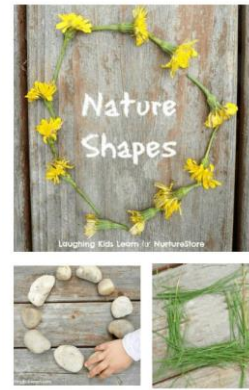
Make a Garden Potion

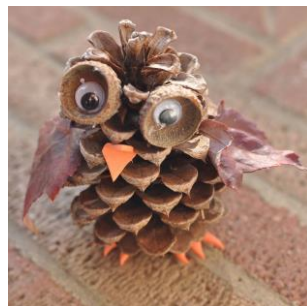
Name Writing
