before creating a final draft.

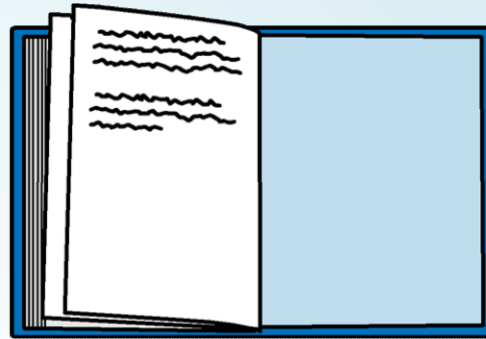

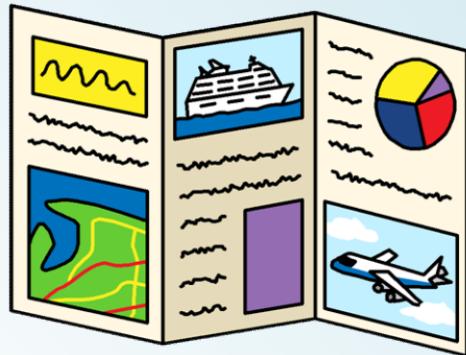
Write a letter to a main character in a book and then write a reply.
