before creating a final draft.

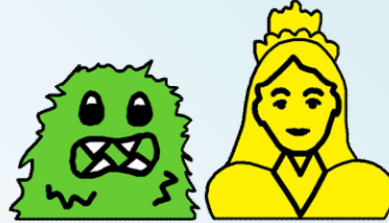

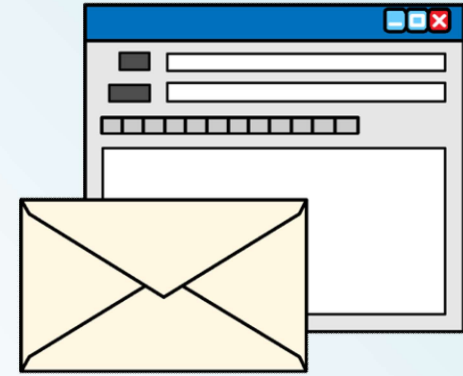

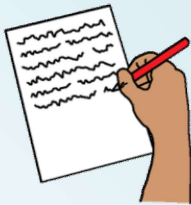
Write a news article about an important event or theme from a book.



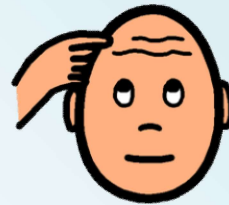
Choose two characters from a story and write a conversation that they might have.



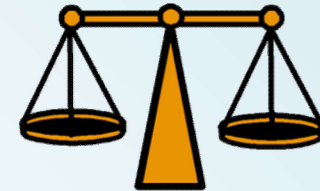
Write a letter or email to a friend recommending a book you have just read.
