**THINKING BACK LOOKING FORWARD PROFILE – P2-P7**

Dear parent/carer,

Enclosed is your child’s current profile. These profiles are a new approach to engaging home with learning which we are trialling this session. You received a similar profile before the parent appointments in October and have had opportunities throughout the session to share learning with pupils at our Families Learning Together Sessions. You will receive a summative report of the progress for the whole session in June.

The enclosed profile is information on where your child is with learning *at the current point*. For all children this varies throughout the year and is intended to give you information to help your child at home and as a starting point for dialogue at the parent appointment next week.

In the profile the pupils also share their views on their learning and it is worth discussing this with them at home. The pupils and teachers both show their understanding of the child attitude and motivation to learning within several key attitude descriptors by colouring one of three faces ☺☹☹. Below is the descriptive scale pupils and teachers use when deciding which “face” to select in each area.



I consistently maintain this with only a few reminders



I find this tricky and need frequent reminders



I rarely maintain this and need regular reminders and interventions

We have worked hard this year on helping home and school share learning better and will continue to work on this in the coming session. We hope you find the profile useful and it helps when you have your parent appointment next week.
