P1- Term 2 (October - December)

The main focus for learning this term will be:

Literacy

Listening and Talking

- Continuing to develop communication skills
- Listening to different texts and media to obtain information

Writing

- Forming taught letters and sounds
- Writing common words
- Writing 3 to 4 letter words featuring known letter sounds
- Labelling pictures
- Writing facts and short sentences

Reading

- Blending letter sounds to read short words.

- Identifying non-fiction text and their features
- Talking about events and characters in a story

- Number Processes: Adding using concrete materials and number lines. Using the language of addition, ordering numbers, number formation
- Time: Reading o'clock times on a digital and analogue clock
