General Reminders (Your 'On the Fridge' Sheet)

- Please ensure your child's snack is **separate** from their packed lunch. Lunchbox trollies are stored away in the morning and children will not be able to access them until lunchtime.
- If there are any changes to your child's arrangements at the end of the day, can you please let the office know **as soon as possible**. We are unable to dismiss children if we have not been informed.
