

The main focus for learning this term will be:

Weather and Climate

Literacy

Reading: This term, the children will be looking at reading for information and note taking. We will be reading a variety of different texts and linking these with our topic and our writing/listening and talking. We will be using our note taking skills during Newsround and to help us when researching different areas in topic. As well as this, all the children will be continuing with their reading books. We will also be striving to have ERIC time every day.

Writing: Our main focus in writing will be poetry writing. The children will be looking at a variety of poems and thinking about the techniques used in them. They will be creating their own poems and reflecting on their effectiveness. We will also be doing more work on functional writing through creating posters with information on our topic. They will also continue developing their core skills – capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and connectives.

Handwriting: We will be continuing to work on joining our letters and using cursive in our work.

Spelling: The class will be exploring spelling patterns and continuing to develop their sight words.

Listening and Talking: The children will be working on their presenting skills and discussing the ways in which to be good speakers and listeners. We will also be completing weekly listening and talking exercises to help with our concentration and focus on key details.
