Independent Learning

When your child comes to nursery, they are able to choose if they want to play inside or outside through the day. An adult is always there to help with coats and shoes but it much less frustrating for the child if they are able to get ready by themselves. When arriving and leaving with your child we would ask that you would encourage them to find their own peg, take off and put on their own jackets and shoes and return their shoes to their own box.

Next week Miss Young will be visiting the nursery in Dechmont. Last term Mrs Arthur visited Uphall nursery. This gives our staff the opportunity to experience learning at other nurseries.

Reminders

- Please do not let any children play on outdoor equipment. This for safety reasons.
- Please ensure children don't bring their own toys to nursery. If these get lost or broken it can be very distressing for the child.
- Please make sure that your children are picked up on time at the end of the session. AM children MUST be collected by 11.15am and the PM children by 4.15pm.
- If your child requires breakfast in the morning please encourage them to come as soon as they arrive at nursery. Breakfast is served until 8.40. Snack will be served short time later at 9.30.
- Please remember to shut the nursery gate, using both the top and bottom bolts when entering and leaving the nursery playground. This is for the safety of the children.
