Literacy

- Reading: Whole class book study using the fiction text, The Twits by Roald Dahl. Grammar will focus on adjectives and alphabetical order. Children will visit the library weekly to promote reading for enjoyment.
- Phonics consolidation of consonant blends
- Writing will link to class topic. Children will plan/create short stories. Fact files. Revision of full stops/capital letters. Using adjectives.
- Handwriting developing letter formation.
- Listening and Talking developing skills using Listen, Think and Do resource.
