Play games on Sumdog or Topmarks to improve your Maths skills.



Look for and read as many types of non-fiction texts as you can. E.g. holiday brochures, leaflets, catalogues, menus, recipes etc.

When watching TV or a film, think about how the characters are feeling. What triggered the emotion and how did they behave?

Look for patterns in nature. Can you copy the pattern onto paper? Think about the visual elements of line, shape, size, colour and texture.

Practise counting forward and backwards in 3s and 4s.

Do an activity to practise the spelling patterns you have been learning in class.

Help an adult prepare a snack or a meal at home. Can you name which food groups the ingredients belong to?

Find different types of packaging in your home and make a list of those that can be recycled. What materials are they made from?

Practise addition and subtraction calculations within 100.

Watch Newsround and discuss with an adult. Look out for stories related to the environment and share with the class.

Keep an Active Diary for a week and record how much activity you get each day. E.g. walked to school, played in the playground, had PE, went swimming etc.

Create a map from a bird's-eye view of a room in your home or a place in the local area. Try using shapes and symbols to represent objects and features (e.g. trees and buildings).

Look for examples of 2D and 3D shapes at home and outside. Can you name them?

1. What was the best thing that happened at school today?
2. Tell me something that made you laugh today.
3. Tell me a new word that you heard today.
4. If I called your teacher tonight, what would they tell me about you?
5. How did you help somebody today?
6. Tell me one thing that you learned today.
7. Tell me about three different times you used your pencil today at school.
8. What was the most popular game at break/lunch?
