

P3 Spelling Activity Grid

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Read, cover, write, check</u></p> <p>Write out your words using 'Read, cover, write, check'.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Spelling Tennis</u></p> <p>Ask someone at home to play spelling tennis with you. Take it in turns to spell each letter in each of your words. You could try this while throwing a ball to each other.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Sentences</u></p> <p>Write sentences using your spelling words. Remember to use a capital letter, punctuation and a connective (<i>and, but, because, so, if, however</i>).</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Rainbow Writing</u></p> <p>Write out your spelling words using a different colour for each letter.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Capitals (Uppercase) and Lowercase Words</u></p> <p>Write all of your spelling words in capitals and then write them using lowercase. E.g. YOU you</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Telephone Words</u></p> <p>First write your spelling words in a list. Then look at a telephone keypad and translate each letter in your words into the numbers on the keypad. E.g. sunny=78669</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Dotty Letters</u></p> <p>Write your spelling words in dots using a writing pencil then join them together with a coloured pencil.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>3D Creative Words</u></p> <p>Make your spelling words out of something different. Try Playdough, pasta or breakfast cereal. How creative can you be?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Flashcards</u></p> <p>Write each of your spelling words two times on paper or card to make flashcards. Play Snap or Match with them.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Rounders</u></p> <p>Use cushions to mark out four bases. Ask an adult to select one of your spelling words. Every time you spell a word correctly, you can move to the next base.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Back Writing</u></p> <p>Ask an adult to write a spelling word on your back using their finger. Can you name the word? Repeat for all of your words then switch places.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Cheer Words</u></p> <p>Pretend to be a cheerleader and call out the letters of your spelling words. Cheer up high for tall letters, e.g. 'b'. Hands on hips for small letters e.g. 'a'. Cheer down low for letters that hang down low e.g. 'j'.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Hide and Seek</u></p> <p>Write each of your spelling words on separate pieces of paper and ask an adult to hide them in a room. Can you find and correctly read all your words? Can you spell them correctly?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Typed Words</u></p> <p>Type each spelling word three times. Can you change the font, size and colour of the print? (NB – You don't have to print this out)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Bubble Writing</u></p> <p>Write out each of your words using bubble writing then colour them in or draw patterns in the letters.</p>
