Ask your grown up if you can count some coins. Once you have added them up, can you arrange them from smallest to greatest value.	Write about your experience of performing in the Circus last week. What was your favourite part? How did you feel? Can you remember the order of the circus acts?	Washing your hands regularly is very important just now. Make some posters to put up around your house to remind your family to do this.	Your grown up wasn't able to come in and see your circus performance last week. Why don't you plan and perform your own Circus for them at home?
Coin rubbings - Place the coins under a bit of white paper. Take a coloured pencil or crayon and rub it over the coin until the coin design appears. Now write the value of the coin beside it. This is a useful way to help you remember the different coin values.	Magic "e" challenge - In your home learning jotter list as many magic "e" words as you can, then write some sentences with them. Practise counting forwards and backwards to 50, 100 and beyond. How high can you go with your counting?	Take out one of the reading books that have been sent home. Before you begin to read. Can you make a prediction of what you think will happen in the story. In your home learning jotter, Write the book title, draw a picture and write some sentences of what you think will happen in the story.	Can you make your bed in the morning and keep your room tidy. This will be very helpful for your grown up!	You all know I have a little dog called Poppy, Do you have any pets? Can you draw me a picture of them in your home learning book? If you don't have a pet, can you draw a picture of what your dream pet would be?
