

The main focus for learning this term will be:

Castles

Literacy

- Reading - whole class reading focus for the first three weeks. Children will share thoughts/predictions about characters from the text. Group reading with a focus on developing reading fluency.
- Spelling/phonics - Assessment/revision of AIL Block 1 Common Words. Starting to work through Block 2 common and diagraph words.
- Writing - Revising sentence structure (full stops, capital letters and finger spaces). Focus on Descriptive writing and beginning to look at nouns, adjectives, verbs.
- Handwriting - Recapping letter formation/size and practising writing new sounds 'sh', 'ch' etc.
- Listening and Talking - personal responses to class texts. Sharing opinions and listening to/respecting the opinions of others.

Numeracy/Maths

- Numeracy focus. Assessment/revision of key concepts (forward/backwards number sequences, place value, number bonds to 20, recognition of numerals and numeral words).

Health and Wellbeing

- Building our community - school values, class charter.
- Exploring emotions (daily check in)
- PE - Balance and control/Team games / Benchball

Interdisciplinary Learning

- Social Studies skills covered
 - Exploring the roles people play in my life and the community
 - Using evidence to talk about life in the past
 - Exploring job roles and the world of work
- Science Skills
 - Exploring properties of Materials
- Art and Design Skills
 - Using different elements of colour, tone and texture to design work and solve real life design problems.
- Technologies Skills
 - Using different materials to recreate models of buildings thinking about the quality of the material.
