

### The main focus for learning this term will be:

'Ranger Jane' (local area focus – country parks & woodlands)

### Literacy

- Reading – group reading, with a focus on developing reading fluency/expression. Children will share predictions about class texts and discuss key features.
- Spelling/phonics – Assessment/revision of key patterns. Common words.
- Writing – Descriptions. Exploring the 'Description Bubble' and writing a variety of different pieces.
- Handwriting – Recapping letter formation/size.
- Listening and Talking – personal responses to class texts. Sharing opinion and listening to/respecting the opinions of others.
- French – greetings. Classroom language. Numbers.

### Numeracy/Maths

- Numeracy focus – assessment/revision of key concepts.
- Forward/backward number sequences.
- Place value.
- Numeral recognition/number words.
- Strategies for addition/subtraction and consolidation of number bonds.
- Time – recapping 'half past' and 'quarter past'. Using timers.

### Health and Wellbeing

- Building our community – school values, class charter.
- Exploring wellbeing indicators.
- 'Emotion Works' recovery curriculum (exploring emotions).
- Health and hygiene (hand washing/sanitising).
- PE – skills for football. Team games/activities.

### Interdisciplinary Learning

Local area study ('Ranger Jane'):

- Social Studies skills covered – characteristics of our local environment. Living things and their habitats. Map skills.
- Technologies skills covered – Sketching ideas. Model making. Following directions.
- Maths skills covered – journeys/directions. Grid references. Data handling.
- Science skills covered – living things. Food chains.
- Drama skills covered – negotiating roles. Responding to scenarios in role.
- Art & design skills covered – planning a solution to a design challenge. How does art & design help us in real life?

### Discrete Learning

- RME – food and festivals.
- Music – creating and performing.

### Opportunities for personal achievement and involvement in the ethos and life of the school

- 'Living Our Values' certificates.

### Other information
