(Find the list of word boost words for our first 4 books on Seesaw)</p>	<p><b>Task 8</b></p> <p>Think of 3 things you have achieved this week that you are proud of. Can you tell someone at home about them or draw a picture of you achieving them?</p>	<p><b>Task 11</b></p> <p>Use your recycling at home to build something new. Think about what materials you can use to hold it all together. Post a picture on Seesaw of what you manage to create.</p>
