Write a book review on a book of your choice. Remember to include the title, author, illustrator, the main characters, your favourite part and how many stars out of five.

Help a family member or friend with something. It could be tidying up in the garden, putting shopping away or anything to help them out.

Research a famous person who has been discriminated against. Find out the effect it had on them. Create a fact file, power point slide show or a sway.
