



# PUSCPS – LEARNING OVERVIEW

## P3/2 – Term 1 (August -October 2023)

### The main focus for learning this term will be:

Building our Community

Fairy tales

### Literacy

- Reading - Whole class reading focused on Fairy tales. Group reading with a focus on developing reading fluency and confidence.
- Spelling/phonics - Revising initial sounds and continuing to learn vowel digraphs (ee, ea, ai, ay)
- Writing - Revising sentence structure (full stops, capital letters and finger spaces). Focus on Descriptive writing how to use adjectives to add more information.
- Handwriting - Recapping letter formation/size and practising writing new sounds 'ee', 'ea', 'oy', 'oa' etc.
- Listening and Talking - personal responses to class texts. Sharing opinions and listening to/respecting the opinions of others.

### Numeracy/Maths

- Numeracy focus. Forward/backwards number sequences to 100, place value up to 3 places, addition and subtraction of numbers within 20, number bonds to 10/ 20.
- Maths focus - Data handling,

### Health and Wellbeing

- Building Resilience
- PE - Ball skills, Co-operative games

### Interdisciplinary Learning

- Social Studies skills covered
  - To explore my community and the groups within it, I can identify and consider different types of housing and how they meet needs
- Maths skills covered
  - I can find shape/patterns with more than one line of symmetry
  - I can complete a more complex shape to make it symmetrical, with at least one line of symmetry
  - I can complete a basic 2D shape to make it symmetrical
- Art and Design Skills
  - I can create and present work using the visual elements of line, shape, form, colour, tone, pattern and texture.
  - I enjoy creating, choosing and accepting roles, using movement, expression and voice.
  - I have developed confidence and skills in creating and presenting drama which explores real and imaginary situations, using improvisation and script.

- RME - Rosh Hashanah - Judaism
