PUSCPS – LEARNING OVERVIEW

P1 – Term 3 (January - April)

The focus for learning this term will be:

Scotland/Space

Literacy

Reading

- Segmenting and blending of CVC words
- Likes and dislikes
- Letter sounds and form
- Exploring stories – building skills for reading
- Weekly reading book
- Daily stories during milk & story

Writing

- Foundations of writing – 2 part stories and adding detail using patterns
- Letter formation – ensuring rhymes are followed
- Drawing skills – free writing opportunities
- Sharing thoughts and experiences (working independently, little scribing)
- Alphabet – forming upper and lower case correctly
- Topic based writing
- Capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and question marks
- Mark making opportunities - daily

Phonics/Tricky Words

- Learning of sounds weekly – further information will be sent home for reinforcement through home learning
- Tricky words – new words weekly with further reinforcement needed at home
- Segmenting and blending of sounds

Listening & Talking

- Final initial sounds (Jolly Phonics/Colourful consonants)
- Real and nonsense words
- PM Oracy – listening and talking focus
- Teaching children to listen – supporting learners' ability to listen for information
- Circle Time (weekly)

Numeracy/Maths

Number Talks

- Counting in 2s
- Counting in 5s
- Counting in 10s

Numeracy and Maths

- Numerals (11-20/30) – formation, recognition and ordering
- Addition & Subtraction – building on knowledge from T2.
- Doubles and half numbers within 10
- Fractions of a shape, object or group
- Data analysis – collecting information, tally marks, pictograms and interpreting information.

Health and Wellbeing

PE

- Tennis
- Athletics/Fitness
- Gross Motor Skills (throwing, catching, using equipment)

Interdisciplinary Learning

Space

- Children's areas of interests will be explored during this topic through out questioning prior to the topic beginning.
