

**Remember:-**

If you multiply by **10**, move all the digits **ONE** place to the left  
If you multiply by **100**, move all the digits **TWO** places to the left  
If you multiply by **1000**, move all the digits **THREE** places to the left

To multiply by **20**, multiply by **10** then times by **2**  
To multiply by **300**, multiply by **100** then times by **3**  
To multiply by **4000**, multiply by **1000** then times by **4**
