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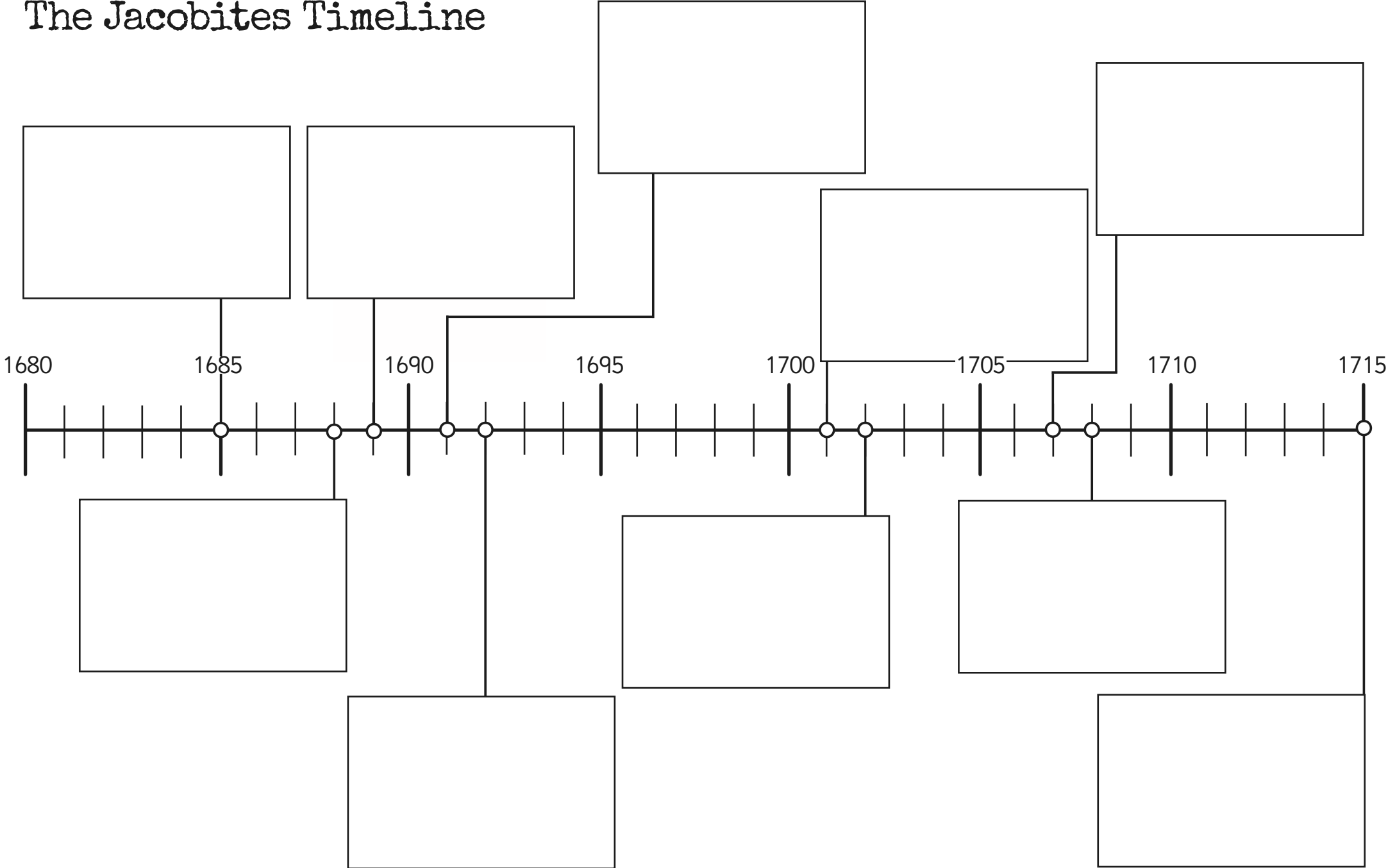
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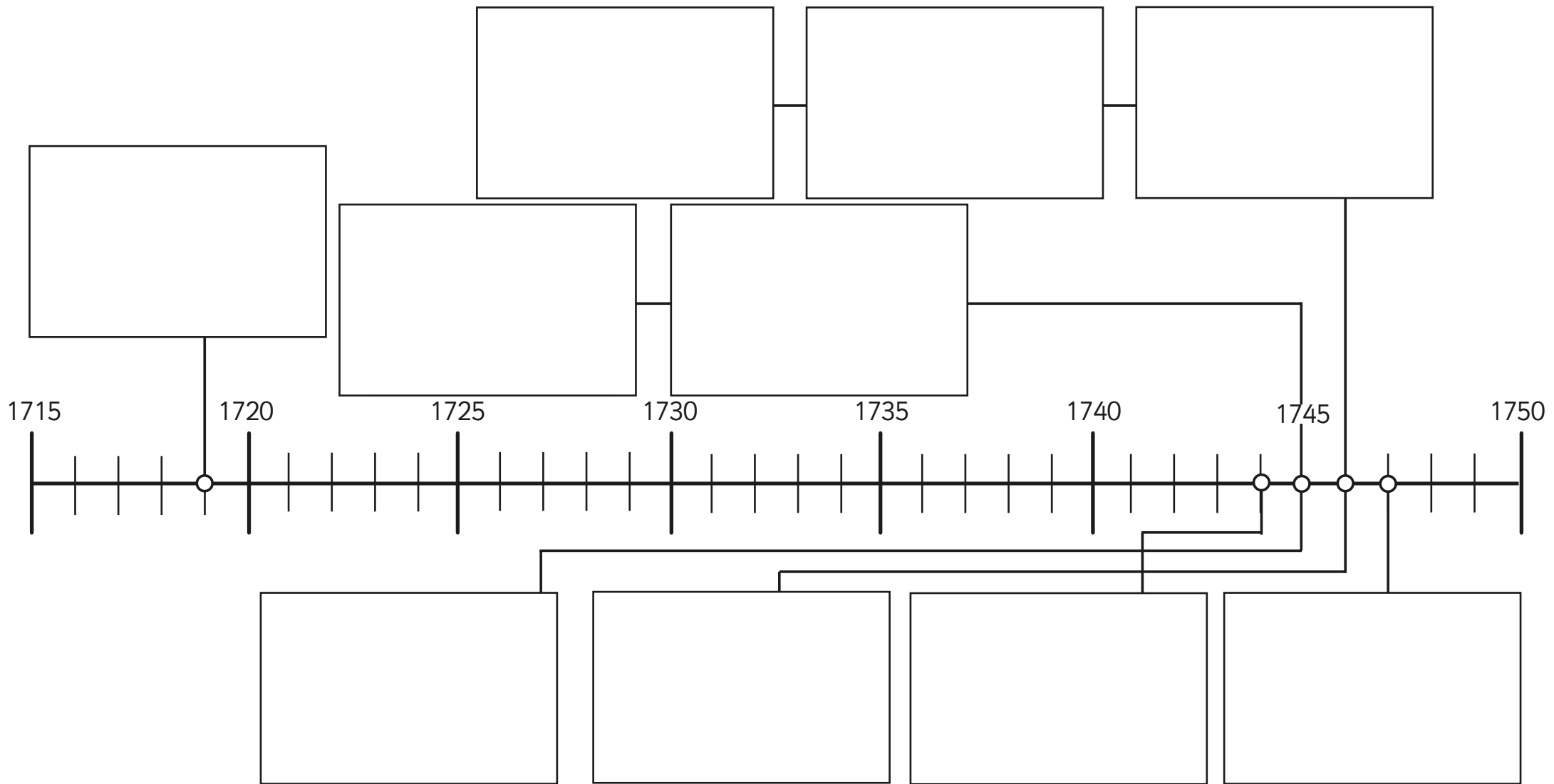
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## Can you mark these events on the timeline?

<p><b>17th September 1745:</b> The Prince and his army enter Edinburgh. He takes up residence at Holyrood Palace.</p>	<p><b>19th August 1745 :</b> The Raising of the Standard at Glenfinnan.</p>	<p><b>1685:</b> James VII of Scotland and II of England is an unpopular king.</p>	<p><b>1719:</b> The Government recruits Highland soldiers; the Black Watch.</p>	<p><b>1691:</b> The King offers to pardon the clans who had fought against him if they swear loyalty to him before New Year's Day 1692.</p>
<p><b>1708:</b> The King of France gives James ships and soldiers to win back Scotland. James has measles and cannot join the fleet. The ships sail home after spotting the British Navy.</p>	<p><b>1689:</b> John Graham or Bonnie Dundee starts the first Jacobite uprising. His army meet King William's army at the Pass of Killiecrankie. The Jacobites win the battle but Graham is killed.</p>	<p><b>1688:</b> King James marries again and his son James is born. William and Mary announce themselves the new King and Queen. King James and his son flee to France.</p>	<p><b>1715:</b> The new King is called George. A battle is fought at Sherriffmuir between the Jacobites and King George's army. The Old Pretender arrives in Peterhead. He only stays for a few weeks.</p>	<p><b>1701:</b> King James dies. His son James is now known as The Pretender. James has a son called Charles; known as The Young Pretender or Bonnie Prince Charlie.</p>
<p><b>21st September 1745:</b> The Battle of Prestonpans. The Jacobites win. General Cope's army are defeated.</p>	<p><b>1707:</b> The Union of the Parliaments; riots take place in Scotland against this.</p>	<p><b>1692:</b> On the 13th February soldiers massacre the sleeping clans folk in Glencoe.</p>	<p><b>16th April 1746:</b> The Battle of Culloden. This was the last battle fought on British soil.</p>	<p><b>1744:</b> George II is King. Bonnie Prince Charlie lands in Scotland to start the '45.</p>
<p><b>1702:</b> The English Parliament propose the Union of the Parliaments to stop the Scottish Government choosing their own King or Queen.</p>	<p><b>September 1746:</b> Bonnie Prince Charlie leaves Scotland for the last time after escaping to Skye disguised as Flora MacDonald's maid.</p>	<p><b>November, December 1745 :</b> The Jacobites march to England. Carlisle is taken and they reach Derby, where they decide to retreat.</p>	<p><b>17th January 1746 :</b> The Jacobites win the battle of Falkirk and defeat General Hawley's army.</p>	<p><b>1747:</b> New laws are passed against the Highlanders as punishment for their support of the Jacobite cause.</p>
