## 20 BRIGHT IDEAS

#### O KICKSTART WORLD BOOK DAY IN YOUR SCHOOL

#### **READING TOGETHER**



#### WHOLE SCHOOL READING

try one of these for fixed times or when the bell rings throughout the whole day and everyone must grab their nearest book to read:



**DEAR:** Drop Everything and Read. **DEAR:** Drop Everything and Reflect.

ERIC: Everyone Reads In Class.



BOOK BLITZ children share a favourite book with a friend. They read it to them and tell them why they love it in 1 minute, then swap.



PAIRED READING older children read with younger children.



SWAPSIES teachers swap classes and read their favourite book or poem.

#### WRITING



STORYCRAFTING children write a short story to make a class anthology. Take a look at our author writing tips in Storycraft worldbookday.com/Storycraftvideos.



WEIRD WRITE-ALL children write one paragraph or page of a story and pass it on to create a (rather strange!) combined story.



AUTHOR AND ILLUSTRATOR RESEARCH children research their favourite author or illustrator and write about their life and books (a good one if you're completing Arts Award!).

#### DRESSING UP & FUNDRAISING



COSTUME PARADE children model their literary outfits, hats or masks, and recite a line, make an action, or explain why they like the character to the rest of the class.



**CHARACTER STUDY** children present their chosen character to classmates, talking about the values they represent, e.g. Mary Poppins is caring, Charlie Bucket loves his family.



MAKE PROPS to wear together, create masks, glasses, beards or whole costumes using Book Aid International's downloadable activity sheets. Children can be a whole range of characters and raise money for charity at the same time.

RUN A BOOK SWAP THEME DAY or FESTIVAL OF THE IMAGINATION create lots of fairground stalls eg Swap a

Book, Hook a Duck, Madame Bibliothèque telling reading futures, the magic of books with a magician, etc.



Hold a BOOK SALE, BOOK SWAP or BOOK FAIR.



#### **GET OUIZZICAL**

RUN A QUIZ try The Bumper Book Quiz or create your own. worldbookday.com/quiz



**GUESS MY BOOK** literary charades for children and teachers or Who Am I? quiz where teachers provide a title for their own 'autobiography' and children have to match the teacher to the title.



STORY SACKS AND BOOK BOXES

children place items in a shoe box or sack linked to a particular book for their classmates to guess.

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SPELLING BEE have fun with words like 'splendiferous' and 'Gruffalo'. Prizes could include book vouchers or stationery.

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RUN A READATHON a sponsored read for a week or a month.

#### **DESIGN & DECORATE**

**DESIGN A BOOK COVER, poster,** bookmark or book bunting to decorate the school or library - pupils can design the using their favourite book jackets or reading slogans.



Decorate a door with a book theme  $\mathcal{V}$ - each with a different book title.




**CREATE BOOK CHARACTERS** from potatoes, wooden spoons or hardboiled eggs.





# WORLD BOOK DAY CHECKLIST


, Y	our cut-out-and-keep checklist of the key things to do to prepare for the <b>BIG</b> Day!
	<b>DESIGN YOUR ACTIVITIES</b> – think about what you want pupils to actually do on World Book Day. We have flexible menus of ideas for each age group, from 5-minute games to a whole day of general literary merriment across the curriculum.
	<b>GET OTHER STAFF AND PUPILS INVOLVED</b> in the planning and running of the day – it's easier to share the workload, and they'll enjoy it!
	It's all about the books on World Book Day (obvs). <b>GO THROUGH 2017'S</b> WORLD BOOK DAY BOOK SELECTION with your students. If you have a good relationship with your local bookshop, you MAY be able to order your pupils' chosen titles, to avoid disappointment.
	Book your <b>SPECIAL VISITOR</b> . It could be an author, illustrator, librarian or bookseller. They'll help to bring the magic of books alive!
	Plan your visit to the bookshop or set up a pop-up shop in your school to <b>REDEEM THE WORLD BOOK DAY BOOK TOKENS</b> .
	<b>PLAN YOUR WORLD BOOK DAY ASSEMBLY</b> (we've done the hard work for you, so download our presentations from worldbookday.com/resources).
	If you're <b>DRESSING UP</b> as your favourite book character, start planning props and simple costumes with plenty of time in advance (see lots of quick and easy upcycling ideas and prop templates at bookaid.org/worldbookday) to be created as an art/craft activity. Don't forget a copy of the book too!
	<b>LET PARENTS KNOW</b> what you're doing for World Book Day, and invite them to be part of the celebrations.
	<b>DECORATE</b> your school, be it the library, communal areas, the hall, book boxes or doors of every classroom. This is a brilliant way to get the creative juices flowing and bring the whole school together.


Every entry must be signed by the teacher, who must print in capitals on the reverse of the entry the pupil's full name and age, school name, address and phone number. Send entries to:
