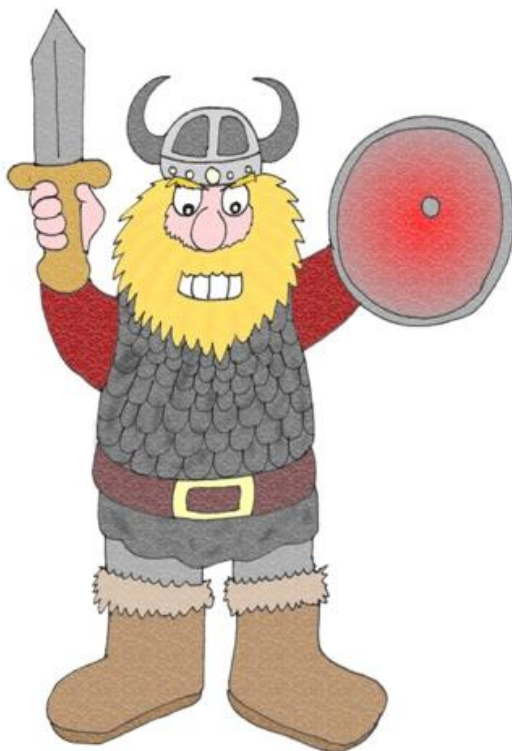

In the saga...	
Name	Reminder
Loki	Viking god of fire and great friends with Odin
Odin	Chief of all the Viking gods
Asgard	City of the gods
Midgard	Home for humans. Loki: 'Isn't it a bit too good for skinny, hairy things like them?'
Jotunheim	Frozen land of the giants. Loki: 'I'm not going there for my holidays!'
Bifrost	The rainbow bridge which connects Asgard to Midgard
Helheim	The underground realm of Hel - a place of evil
Yggdrasil	The world ash tree - holding all the realms together
