Steps

1. Walk to the end of Banks Road.

4. Stop at the street crossing.
5. Press the silver button on the pole.
6. Wait for the traffic to stop and the green 'Walk' sign to flash.
7. Look both ways, then walk across High Street.
8. Turn left and walk to the corner of High Street and Bridge Road.
9. Turn right and walk up Bridge Road to the river path.
10. Follow this path to Millers Park.
