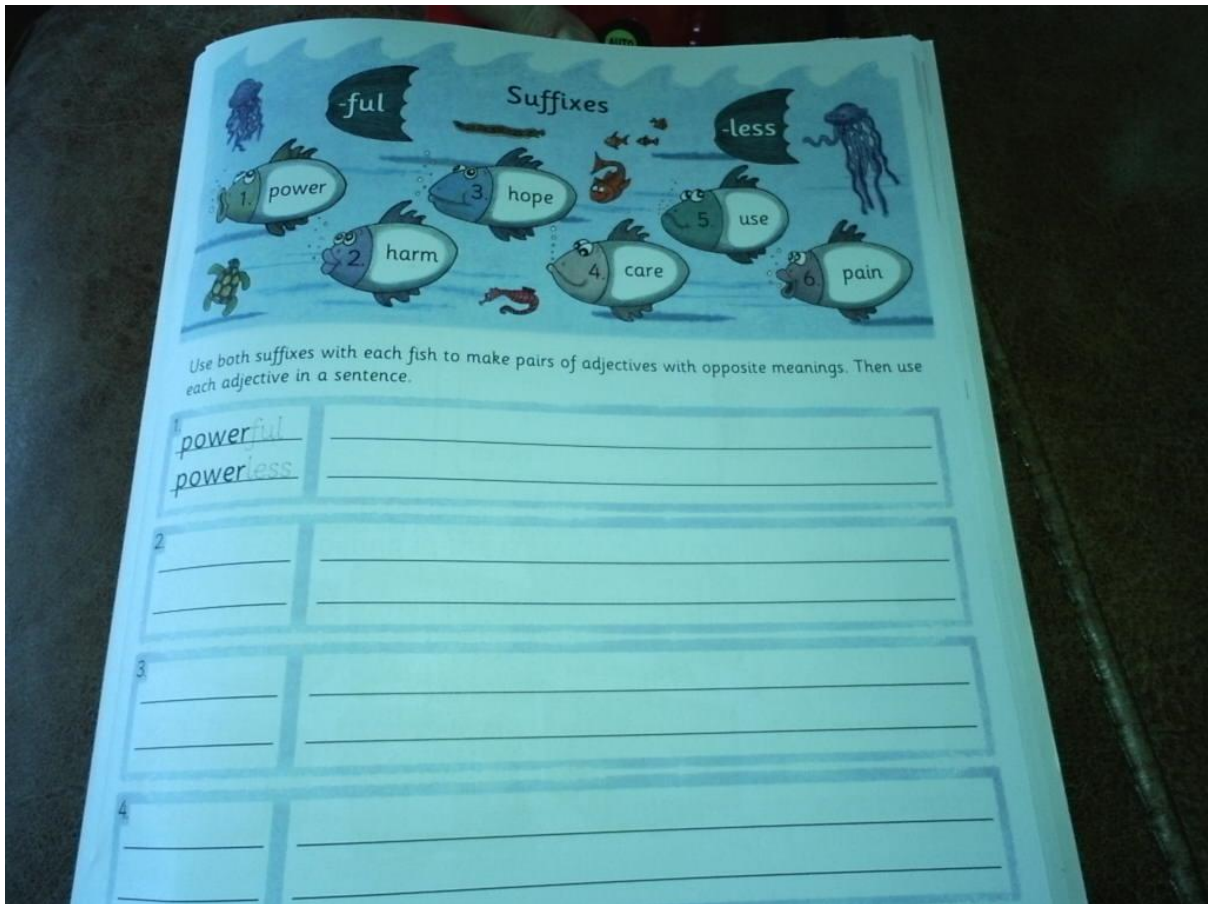

- There are 6 sets of words so 12 in all – number your sentences 1-6



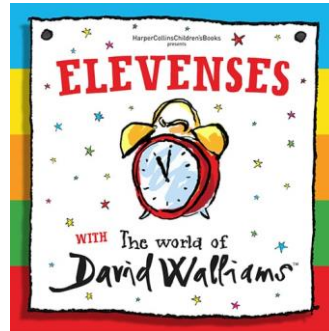
How do you feel about suffixes?
