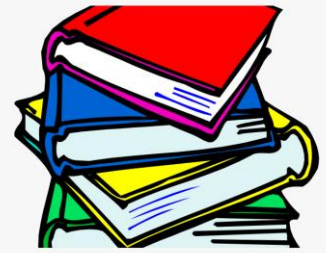

I can sort books into categories.

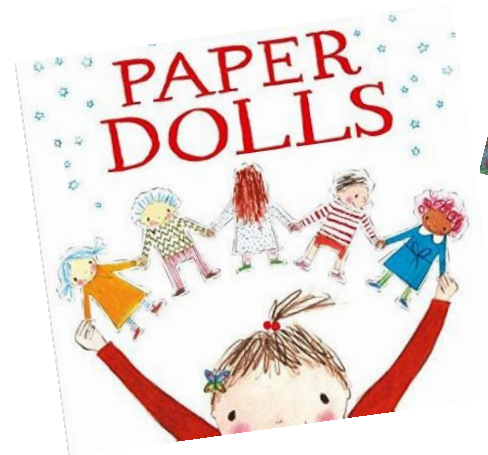
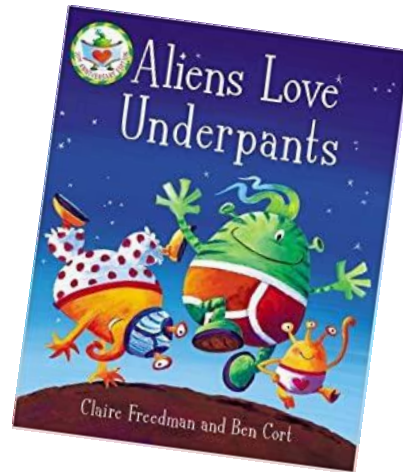
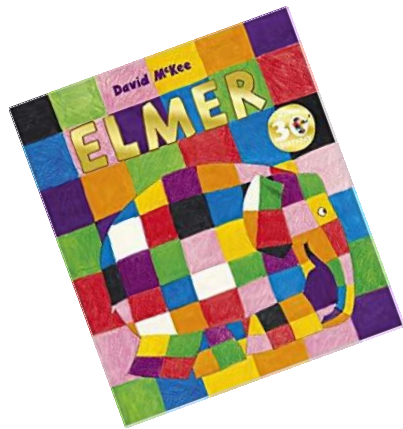
I can choose my favourite book or author and explain my choice.

Here is a collection of my books. I like them all but can you guess my favourite from my description?

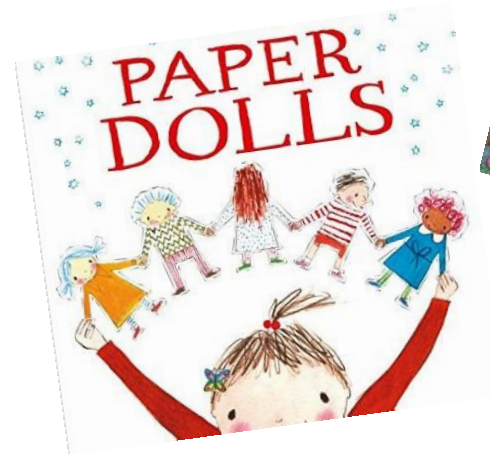
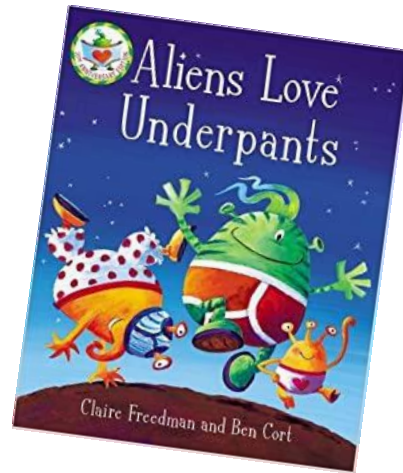
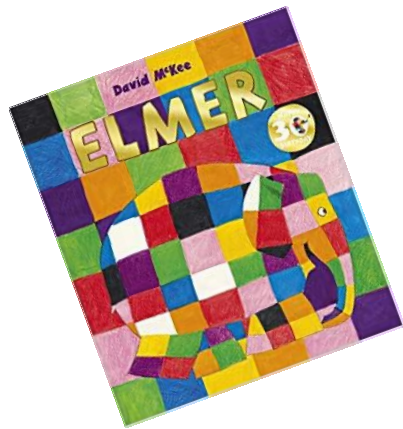


This is my favourite book because I love the illustrations (drawings) and it makes me feel happy.

Did you guess?

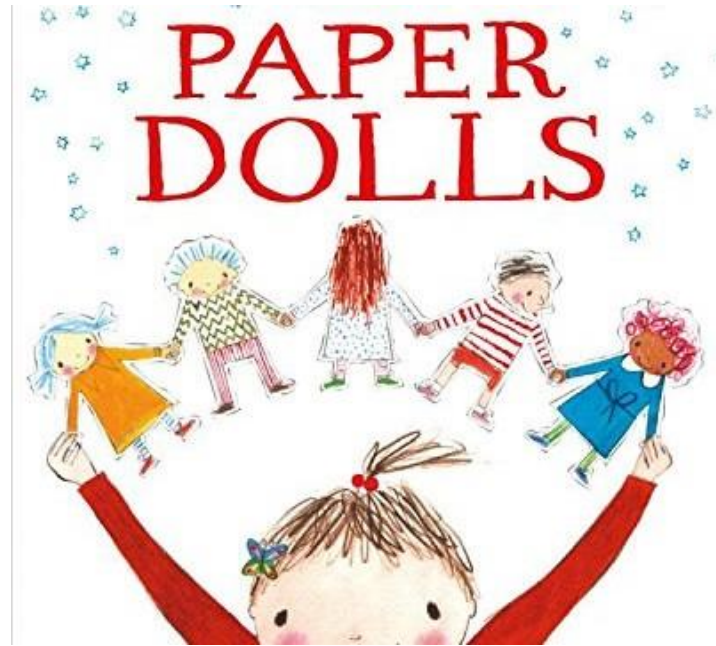
Here's another clue:

► Think:

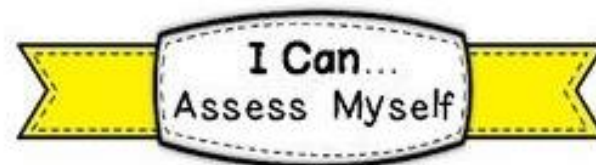
Did you manage to sort your books and choose your absolute favourite book?
