Steps to Success

I can organise my thought into paragraphs (chunks of writing).

I can write my notes into sentences.

Remember! For our next writing task we will be conveying an experience...

Today you will be writing your first draft piece of writing about lockdown.

Remember your notes now need to be written into full sentences that make sense...

Say the sentence, write the sentence then read it to check it makes sense!

You can write about your experience of the lockdown however you would like but remember you need to write in paragraphs. **If you would like some structure follow this guidance...**

Paragraph 1: The first week of lockdown

How did you feel?

What did you do?

How did you get on with your home learning?

What was it like being with your family all day?

Paragraph 2: The first week of Easter holidays

What did you do?

Did you play any games?

Did you speak to your friends on the phone?

Did you have any Easter eggs?

Did anything funny happen?

Paragraph 3: The second week of Easter holidays

How did you keep yourself busy?

Did you do any exercise?

Did you play in the garden?

Did you make anything?

Paragraph 4: Lockdown is continued

How did you feel when you found out lockdown would be continued?

What have you been doing this week?

How have you got on with your home learning tasks?

Have you learnt any life lessons whilst in lockdown (e.g. to appreciate my family, to look after one another)

What do you hope for the future?

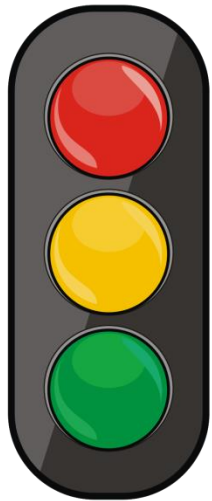
