<p><u>CHARLES RENNIE MACKINTOSH</u> Create a Mackintosh inspired piece of art.</p> 	<p><u>Self Portrait</u> Use a mirror to draw a portrait of yourself</p>	<p><u>Colour Mixing</u> Create as many cool and warm colours as you can using paint, chalk or crayon</p>	<p><u>Found Objects</u> Use any household object to create a repeating print.</p>
<p><u>Paul Klee</u> Create a Klee inspired piece of art.</p> 	<p><u>Visual Elements</u> Experiment with line, shape, pattern and colour.</p>	<p><u>Colour Mixing</u> Practise making tints and shades using white and black using paint or crayon.</p>	<p><u>Recycling Prints</u> Use old cardboard, jars, bubble wrap, etc to print. Make sure it is safe and clean!</p>
<p><u>BRIDGET RILEY</u> Create a Riley inspired piece of art</p> 	<p><u>Media</u> Layer different materials such as pencil, pen, crayons, etc to create new and interesting effects</p>	<p><u>Colour Mixing</u> Practise using complementary colours: Purple and Yellow Green and Red Blue and Orange</p>	<p><u>Relief Printing</u> Use wax crayon and paint to create a relief print.</p>
